Dear Councillor

I refer to your letter dated 25 September concerning the installation of real-time passenger information (RTPI) displays at bus stop nos. 1894 and 1897 in Clonsilla Village, Dublin 15.

At this stage the current phase of RTPI installations has been completed and locations for the next phases have been identified. Bus stop 1894 is among the locations identified for the next phases. However, as you will appreciate the roll-out of these phases is dependent on the continued availability of funding for the RTPI programme.

In the case of bus stop 1897 your request will be taken into account when the existing planned phases have been completed and consideration is being given to future phases.

Of course it is important to point out that although not all bus stops have displays, RTPI information for every bus stop is available through the following ways.

On PCs	By visiting www.transportforireland.ie
On smartphones	By downloading the free <i>Real Time Ireland</i> app from the Apple App store for iPhone and iPad, Google Play store for Android devices or Windows store for Windows phone devices.
On standard mobile phones	By texting the bus stop number to 53035 (e.g. text 807 to 53035). It is also possible to refine the selection at busier stops by texting the bus stop number followed by a space followed by the route number (e.g. text 807 46a). This service costs 30c per message received.
